








Orkney 424

If you need a fast and stable boat for sailing club rescue or harbour patrol, the highly manoeuverable Orkney 424 fills the berth.



Orkney 475

A rugged dory, largest of the Orkney range, ideal if you fish offshore or move heavy loads across the loch. The Orkney 475 is a deep sided, multi-role working sports boat with all the usual dory features and more.

In standard form with forward console and side benches you have a spacious personnel carrier. With custom trim and 85 hp you have high performance and comfort - ORKNEY STYLE.

Design
Over 25 years of boat building experience can be seen in our Naval Architect designed hulls.
Pronounced "V" forward sections for soft rides, spray rails for dry rides and deep topsides for safe rides.
Orkney Dorys feature a central drain channel or "bilge" from which any water between the double skin is drained away. Open the transom drain and self-ball as you speed along.

Closed cell polyurethane foam is used for buoyancy but we place it where it will be most effective.

Construction

Only hand laminated G.R.P. is used in our boats. Each deck is "wet" bonded to its hull, not only round the gunwhale but also below the floor. This makes a tough and rigid structure even before the polyurethane foam is injected. Orkney combines the strength of an integral chassis with the unsinkable safety of sandwich construction.

Features

Accessories are an important part of any Dory and the way these fit and function has always been of prime importance to us. Trailers, canopies, covers, rails and upholstered seating – all these are purpose designed and made to enhance your Orkney Dory. Details which matter to the user are given the closest attention and it is the way we treat the finishing touches that set Orkney Dorys apart. It's the way we fix items like the fender and the way we provide stowage in the steering console. It's the fitting of the canopy and the stripes on the hull . . . It's ORKNEY STYLE.


